Introduction - Fizz Alarms

Fizz Alarms is your every day time manager. From repeating alarms, stopwatches to counters. It's your time so take control.

Installing Fizz Alarms

Fizz Alarms supports Window Mobile 2005 and 2006 with all variants of screen size and resolution. If you have problems knowing what version to install on your device, contact support@fizzsoftware.com for help.

To install, download the zip file and unzip on your PC. With your device connected to your PC via Active Sync or the Windows Mobile Device Center on Windows Vista do the following:-

Double Click on setup.exe

Follow the on-screen installer dialogs.
Check your device and install either to phone or storage card

If you prefer using .cab file to install, or if you have an Apple Mac, you can download the .cab file from our website.

See the product Page and follow the link for documentation and .cab files on that page. Once installed, you can use the product FREE for 3 days, after which you will need to activate it to continue usage.

License Agreement

Please read and accept the license agreement before completing the installation of Fizz Alarms. If you install using the .cab file, then you are also agreeing to the terms and conditions of the License agreement.

Launching Fizz Alarms

Once installed, Fizz Alarms will be available in the Programs list. Select the **Fizz Alarms** icon from the Programs list

Activating Fizz Alarms

Fizz Alarms will function for 3 days before you are required to enter a valid registration code. You may register either by selecting Activation Options from the Menu on the main screen or wait until after 3 days in which case the only available option will be the Activation screen.

To register, simply enter the **Activation code** provided when you purchased the product and click Activate. You may also need to enter your email address.

You will need a valid internet connection (or be connected to your PC via Active Sync) to complete the product activation. Once complete, a green tick will appear, telling you that your product is activated.

If you change your device, you will need to de-activate the software on your old device and then re-activate your software on the new one. The process is simple:-

1. Logon to your Fizz Software Online account at www.fizzsoftware.com/myaccount
2. If you do not have your login details, you can have them sent to you by using the lost password link. The email address here will be the one used when you registered your product. If you have changed your email address since your purchase, email support@fizzsoftware.com , make sure you tell them the email address you originally used.
3. Once you have logged onto your account, choose deactivate.
4. You can now install Fizz Alarms on your new device and then choose Activate, you can use the same registration number, this is listed in your account details.

Fizz Alarms Navigation

The first screen that you see when you start Fizz alarms will show you the three main options available to you, Alarms, Stopwatch and Counters. On touch screen devices you can touch the clock to give you a full screen clock view. Touching it again will return you to the main screen. Non-touch screen devices can do the same thing using the menu. You can also use the menu to toggle between a digital and analog clock.

Top tip for touch screen device users: Whenever you see a list of information, try using your finger to quickly scroll through the list to reach your desired location. The faster you move your finger, the faster the list will scroll.

Alarms

Choose 'Alarms' to view, edit and set your alarms. On non-touch screen devices, use the action key to create a new alarm, you can touch the screen on touch screen devices.

Now simply move up and down the list to set the various options, using your finger or stylus on touch screen devices, or the navigation pad on non-touch screen devices. All times are in 24hr clock format.

The first option is the alarm name, this is also what will be displayed when the alarm runs. Choose Done when you have chosen the name and after each setting change to return you to the main list.

Next you choose the time for the alarm to run. On touch screen devices swipe your finger left and right to change the time. On non-touch screen devices, use the arrow keys on the navigation pad to change the time. This applies to everywhere that you see the double left and right arrows.

Now you can choose the recurring options. You can choose between custom days, monthly, yearly, or once only alarms.

Now choose the sound to be played when the alarm runs. You can now choose to play MP3 files. Just make sure that all sound files are Sounds folder in the Fizz Alarms installation tree, or are in the \Windows folder or the \myringtones folder on your device.

Next is the option for how long to play the alarm for and then the volume. The first option here is to use your current profile settings, so whatever your device volume settings are set to, your Fizz Alarm will be the same.

The final option is snooze, either have the snooze off, or choose one of the duration options.

When the alarm activates, you can choose to change the snooze time by using the left and right arrows to change the snooze time, then select snooze.

You can set as many alarms as you like and view them in the alarm list. See the menu on the alarm list screen for more options, including switching the alarm off and dismissing it early.

Stopwatch

The stopwatch can be controlled either with your finger or stylus on touch screen devices, or using the navigation pad on non-touch screen devices. Press the left navigation arrow or action to start and stop the stopwatch and the right one to record laps. Pressing the right one again once the stopwatch has been stopped will reset. Use the menu to save your lap times to a file that you can then export and view in Excel. Also use the menu to choose the 'Prevent device from sleeping' option.

Counters

Use the menu to set up your counters, you can have as many counters as you want and run them all simultaneously or individually. Set the counters up in the same way as you set up alarms. If you leave the counters screen whilst your counters are running, the counters will stop and reset. You can use the menu to reset the counters, delete them and also prevent the device from sleeping whilst the counters are running.

When the counter finishes, you have the option to complete, which just resets the counter, or snooze it, ie. Start it again for a further period of time. To do this, use the left and right arrows to change the snooze value and then select snooze. The counter will reset for the new snooze value and start counting down.
